Endorsing Ministry in the Global Methodist Church

Q: Will the Global Methodist Church endorse chaplains to serve in institutional and military settings?

A: Yes. The process to endorse new chaplains and to offer Global Methodist Church endorsement to existing chaplains is being created by a team of clergy with major experience in military and non-military ministry settings.
