# 2026 General Conference Preview: Important Details and Timeline Announced

The Commission on General Conference is actively planning all aspects of the 2026 gathering, with the location, dates, and theme to be announced soon! A significant change has been approved: **legislative committee meetings will now take place in person onsite**, **extending the conference from five to seven days**. This decision, overwhelmingly supported by delegates, ensures a more effective and engaging experience without increasing costs.

Key deadlines and processes have also been updated, including revised delegate election and petition submission dates, allowing more time for new conferences to organize. With a strong commitment to transparency and global representation, the **2026 General**Conference will be a historic moment for the Global Methodist Church —and it's happening in Africa! 
## **COMMISSION UPDATES**


