Call to Prayer and Action After Terrorist Attack on Nigerian Christians

On May 23, 2025, the community of Munga Lelau in Taraba State, Nigeria—part of the Global Methodist Church's Northeast Annual Conference—was tragically attacked by Islamic extremists, resulting in the loss of 42 lives and the displacement of many families.

While the exemption is designed for "religious objections," many pastors merely wished to avoid the 15.3% self-employment tax which funds Social Security and Medicare. For pastors on low salaries, the tax was a legitimate concern.

Answering Jesus' Prayer: Ecumenical Unity in Action

Ecumenical Joy!

Jesus prayed it first. As he came to the end of his time on earth, he looked toward Heaven and said, "I am praying not only for these disciples but also for all who will ever believe in me through



their message. I pray that they will all be one, just as you and I are one – as you are in me, Father, and I am in you. And may they be in us so that the world will believe you sent me" (John 17:20-21).

This is the charge of our Ecumenical Relationships Commission. It is to help all of us live into the Father's answer to Jesus' own prayer. Toward that end, our team is continually at work — building relationships with denominations that share our values, exploring opportunities to learn from other tribes, and encouraging local churches to build ecumenical bridges in their own communities.

And we have some successes to share! Our biggest celebration this month is our acceptance as a full partner in the Wesleyan Holiness Women Clergy (WHWC) fellowship. The mission of WHWC is to "advance Christ's Kingdom by engaging, empowering, and equipping women to lead in the Church at every level." This ecumenical group, comprised of multiple Wesleyan denominations, hosts a large gathering every other year for women clergy and ministry leaders. As full partners, we will participate in planning and promoting the next event, which will be held February 23-26, 2026, in Minneapolis, MN.

What a blessed opportunity this will be for our women clergy to be encouraged as they experience this beautiful ecumenical gathering!

We will share more soon about our local church initiatives. Until then, know that together we are leaning into the heart of Jesus as we seek to be one "that the world will believe."




